

Hillside School

Location: South side of Ryan Road, just east of Howell Avenue

District: 10

Built: 1934

Closed: 1956

The first Hillside School was a wood structure built on the north side of Ryan Road in 1860. It was replaced by a brick building in 1892. The wood building was sold for \$11 and used as a granary on the Seymer farm. In 1934, part of the old brick building was moved to the southside of Ryan Road to be part of the new building. The school was closed in 1956 as part of the school consolidation. The building was used in the late 1950s as the Oak Creek City Hall. It was later sold and used for private business purposes. In the 1970s and 80s it housed Millie's Photography.
